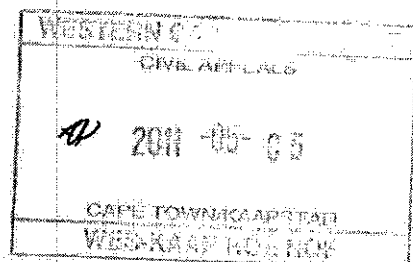

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That First Respondent is placed under provisional liquidation in the hands
of the Master of the High Court.



2. That a Rule *Nisi* is issued calling upon Respondents and all interested parties to show cause, if any, on Monday, 6 June 2011 why the following order should not be made:

2.1 First Respondent is placed under final liquidation.

2.2 The costs of this application are to be costs in the liquidation.

3. That a copy of this Order be served in the following manners:

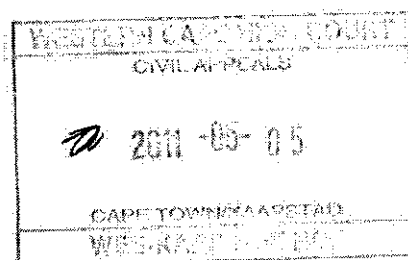
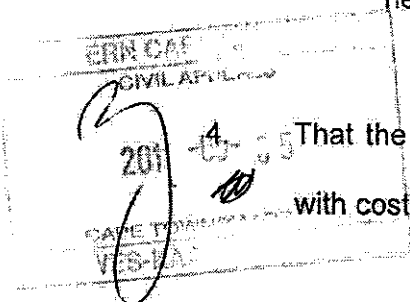
3.1 on the First Respondent at its registered address;
