Upon hearing Counsel for the Applicant, and upon reading the Notice of Motion and the other documents filed of record, it is hereby order that:


- The Respondent company be placed under provisional liquidation in the hands of the Master of the High Court.

 - 5.2 The employees of the Respondent company by affixing a copy of the application and provisional order on any notice board to which the employees have access inside the Respondent company's premises or if there is access to the premises by the employees, by affixing a copy to the front gate or front door of the premises from which the Respondent company conducted any business;
 - 5.3 The South African Revenue Services;





6. That the costs of the application be paid from the estate of the Respondent.
