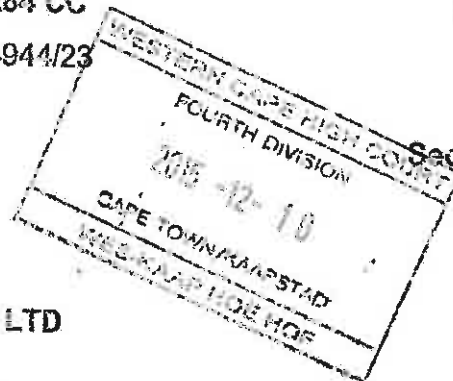

DRAFT ORDER

Having read the papers filed of record and having heard Counsel for the Applicant, the following order is made:

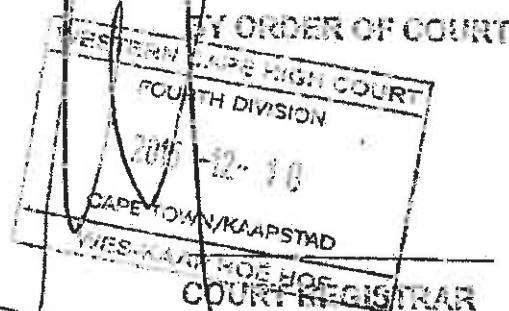
1. The Respondent is placed under provisional liquidation;
2. A rule *nisi* is ordered in terms whereof Respondent and all other interested parties are called upon to show cause, if any, to this Honourable Court on Tuesday, 26 JANUARY 2016 why:
 - 2.1 the Respondent should not be placed under final liquidation;
 - 2.2 the costs of this application should not be costs in the liquidation.

3. Service of this Provisional Order to be effected as follows:

- 3.1 by the Sheriff or his lawful deputy of this Court at the Respondent's registered address at 1106 Courtyard, Gants Centre, Strand and it's principal place of business at Waterford Vineyard, Winery Road, Stellenbosch;
- 3.2 by the Sheriff or his lawful deputy of this Court on employees and trade unions, if any, by affixing to a notice board at the Respondent's principal place of business at Waterford Vineyard, Winery Road, Stellenbosch, alternatively, by affixing a copy thereof to at the entrance of the premises;
- 3.3 on all creditors of the Respondent (known to Applicants) who have claims exceeding R20 000.00 by Applicant's attorney sending a copy thereof to them by registered post or email at least 10 (ten) days prior to the return date;
- 3.4 by the Sheriff or his lawful deputy on the offices of the South African Revenue Services;
- 3.5 on all other interested parties by publication of a shortened form of the provisional order in a Afrikaans and English newspaper at least 10 (ten) days prior to the return date;
- 3.6 by the Applicant's attorney on the Master of the High Court.
